The “**Well Informed**” TWON program is an education program that gives well owners the opportunity to have their well water samples screened for common contaminants including fecal coliform bacteria, nitrates, and high salinity. The screening of the water sample is followed by a one-hour explanation of the screening results and water well protection practices which focuses on wellhead protection and recommendations for remediating well contamination.
