



Culinary Garden Docent Instructions

AgriLife Extension has reopened the opportunity to serve as Culinary Garden Docent at the San Antonio Botanical Gardens (SABoT). To resume volunteering as a Bexar County Master Gardener (BCMG) with the ability to record volunteer hours (VHs) you must:

- Be trained as a Culinary Garden Docent.
- Sign up for volunteer shifts on the VMS. Look for the Culinary Gardens Docent calendar on VMS under the Calendars tab. Or contact Grace Emery at 210-875-6919 or gemery49@yahoo.com.
- You will receive a reminder email, but if you cannot make it let Grace Emery know.
- Place the Veggie Garden sign in the breezeway. There is no sign-in due to COVID.
- All handouts are laminated if visitors want to take a photo.
- Pick up your clicker and apron in the Volunteer Room.
- When you volunteer, wear your Master Gardener badge and a smile!
- When you complete your shift, please make sure the BCMG sign is returned to the volunteer room.
- Record your hours on VMS using the new Code 150.
